The Bible was the primary literary resource in many early American homes, providing inspiration for nineteenth century quilters, who mostly used scraps and outgrown or clothing beyond repair to sew covers to keep their loved ones warm. Throughout our True Story study series, a variety of quilt blocks representing Bible stories or themes will be presented.

This week's quilt is Doves at the Window. There are at least thirteen different quilt block patterns with "dove" in the name. Each reminds us of the story of Noah and the great flood. Doves are symbolic of love and gentleness. "Doves at the window" might suggest spontaneous joy and great presence.
