New Adult CE Classes Start this Sunday

Celtic Wisdom for Seeking the Sacred

Celtic monks in the British Isles during the 600-900's sought to imitate the Desert mothers and fathers of early Christianity. Drawing on that desert tradition, spiritual practices from Celtic Christians are valued as helpful to us today, as pilgrims on a spiritual journey. Using the book, The Soul's Slow Ripening by Christine Valters

Paintner, each class session will include an exploration of a Biblical text, an introduction to a Celtic saint and the opportunity to learn about particular Celtic spiritual practices such as encircling prayer, soul friendship, walking the rounds, pilgrimage or more. The class will be led by Pastor Jane in Room 4 by the Kitchen. Cost of the book (available at the first class) is \$12.50.

Adult Bible Study "Discipleship and Mission" Matthew, Luke, Romans

Written by Elizabeth Soto Albrecht, this study surveys several calls to ministry and the expectations of those called.
