Camp Friedenswald is going Solar!!! Over the past two years, Camp Friedenswald has been working towards reducing our energy use through LED lighting, motion sensors, sustainable purchasing, changing our habits - and more!! Camp has now completed the installation of 180 Solar panels to generate energy to power the Dining Hall, cabins, and other facilities on the main camp. The estimated production of the panels will save over 68,000 kWh of energy annually - roughly 25% of Camp's total energy use. Not only will the panels bring a cleaner, renewable source of energy to Camp, but they will also reduce our annual electric expenses. We continue to make energy improvements throughout the Camp.
