Some observations from the past year:

1. We are delighted to end the year in the black! Thank you! Thank you!

2. The balance turned positive for the first time this year at the end of Nov! That is, for the first 10+ months we had a negative balance.

3. Although there were 6 months when income exceeded expenses, 4 of those months were the last 4 months of the year. In the first 8 months of the year, March and April were the only months when income exceeded expense.

4. Over the years, we have often had a negative balance many of the months of the year but when it reached \$50,000 it caused some anxiety. We asked Committees to restrict spending. A question: What suggestions do you have as to how we might work with this situation?
