All: We lament the falsehoods which divided our nation and created unnecessary fear and mistrust of vaccines.

Leader: All this has happened, Lord God, but we have not forgotten your promise to be with us in trouble and delivers us. We know Christ weeps with us and sends us the Holy Spirit to dwell in us, revealing the new thing you are doing among us.

All: You, alone, O God, can turn our mourning into dancing and our grief into joy. We turn to you with grateful hearts for your faithfulness in the midst of our suffering.

North: Bless those who remain hungry, or homeless, or hopeless.

South: Bless those who continue to work courageously and tirelessly to respond to human need.

All: And bless us, your people in this place, as we renew our commitment to follow your ways forward into the new adventure which awaits us.
