Administration Commission Update

Administration Commission has revised and approved several policies in collaboration with the Community Life Commission. They are:

- ·Facility Use Policy,
- ·Meal Policy, and
- ·Wedding Policy.

An updated Facility Use Request Form will be approved shortly. The update includes both custodial and technology service fees, which will be paid directly to the church and distributed to the individuals assisting with the additional services.

MUSA Special Delegate Assembly

The Assembly of Delegates of Mennonite Church USA (MC USA) will be meeting May 27-30, 2022 in Kansas City. Four resolutions will be considered. Full resolution statements are found here.

1) Clarification on Mennonite Church USA Polity and the Role of the Membership Guidelines of Mennonite Church USA

Pastoral accountability is a function of the area conference which holds the credential. It is not the responsibility of the Executive Board. Pastors, congregations, and area conferences discern the appropriateness of performing same-sex marriages in their contexts. Congregations are accountable to area conferences. Conferences have broad latitude in determining membership and credentialing. The original Membership Guidelines for the formation of Mennonite Church USA states that disputes related to section III be resolved by area conferences, not the Executive Board. In that spirit, we commit to the difficult work of being church together amidst our differences working at Biblical justice and reconciliation where there is conflict. **Resolution**: Therefore, we retire the Membership Guidelines as the active polity in Mennonite Church USA.

2) Mennonite Church USA Accessibility Resolution

Resolution: As members of MC USA, we commit to growing as communities of grace, joy and peace without barriers so that God's healing and hope flow through all of us to the world regardless of ability. This resolution affirms that people with disabilities are included within priorities expressed in MC USA Journey Forward.......At all levels of the church, we commit to calling out and employing the leadership gifts of people with disabilities.

3) MC USA for Justice Resolution

This is a study resolution – it will not be voted on at this meeting.

4) A Resolution for Repentance and Transformation

MC USA delegates will determine if this resolution will be discussed and voted on at the Special Session of the Delegate Assembly.

MC USA Staff will ensure the Special Session of the Delegate Assembly is structured to:

- 1) allow time for worship;
- 2) focus on our vision and purpose and the Renewed Commitments;
- 3) build community within which discernment can happen
- 4) and provide a setting in which we are open to the movement of the Holy Spirit

MCN is looking for persons interested in serving as delegates for this Assembly. We are entitled to one Young Adult delegate (aged 16-21) and several Adult delegates. MCN will be covering the cost of registration, travel, and hotel.

A significant amount of preparation time will be required. There are several webinars and much documentation to work through prior to the conference.

Please prayerfully discern whether you are being called to represent our congregation as a delegate. Submit your information for consideration to church@normalmennonite.org by Wednesday, February 23. Registration and reservations need to be secured promptly.

Update from Clara in Columbia

Things have been very busy at work, as the last few weeks we have been busy registering kids for our program. We have almost 200 children registered, which is close to double the amount from last year. We were able to register a large number of Venezuelan migrant children, which is really exciting to be able to reach that population as well. This week the interns will be starting with us and then we we will be starting activities for the children on a regular basis.

The month of February, we are doing weekly workshops for a group of about 15 children with an artist, which will culminate in the painting of a mural in two weeks. It has been super exciting to see the children's excitement for learning about drawing and painting, and the artist has a lot to offer. I'll attach a photo from the workshop at the end of the email.
