The Vision Team met on Monday, June 13. Following the meeting, Vision Team has the following items to share with the congregation:

- 1. Vision Team received regular reports on the current activities of the Spiritual Gifts Discernment Team (SGDT), Pastoral Team Search Committee (PTSC), the Interim Pastoral Team (IPT), and the Commissions and discussed where support is needed. One area of focus was on how the church's online presence can be an increased focus for outreach.
- 2. Vision Team discussed some of the feedback received through its "Office Hours" sessions and how best to follow up/pass along the feedback it has received. The next office hours will be online, Sunday, June 26, at 1:30 PM. More details and a link will be provided in the June 22 Midweek.


