

Worship Commission

Worship - It doesn't just happen?

Do you know what goes into planning each Sunday's worship? It is a rather complex process! The Interim Pastoral Team sets up the schedule of preachers. Worship Commission then has a rotating list of Worship Planners, Accompanists, Song Leaders, & Communion Leaders. For each Sunday, the Planner receives the Sermon title, scripture, & theme from the preacher & then plans the other components of the worship. The Preacher may suggest some hymns, but the Planner normally chooses them or asks the Song Leader to select them. The Planner also chooses people to be Worship Leader (usually the Planner does this), read scripture, & lead the Children's Time. If another Commission or group needs to plan a worship, they need to coordinate with the assigned Worship Planner who may already have plans for that Sunday. You can contact a member of the Worship Commission, the church office, or a member of the Interim Pastoral Team to find out who the Planner is for a given Sunday. We hope this will help us all understand how much good work goes into creating meaningful worship as well as foster good communication in our planning. We are so grateful for the many people who fill these important roles sharing their spiritual gifts in planning & leading the different parts of our worship services. 

Mobile Health Clinic

The Carle Mobile Health Clinic that will be held on Monday, August 15 from 9 am - 4 pm. The mobile health clinic will be at Woodhill Towers in the south parking lot on the third Monday of each month for the rest of the

year from 9 am – 4 pm. It is basically a primary care office on wheels. It is a walk-in clinic and individuals of all ages are welcome to obtain services on the van. There are no out of pocket costs and you can have private insurance, no insurance or Medicaid. The Mobile Health Clinic provides: flu shots, chronic condition management & education, treatment of acute illness, physicals/wellness care/assessments, school & sport physicals/immunizations, lab testing, referrals & applications for social services.

Food boxes will be available for distribution by the Tinerven Foundation. OSF St. Joseph Medical Center will also be available to distribute Smart Meals and nutrition information. The McLean County Health Department will be in attendance to provide health and diabetes prevention information and have some activities for children.


