

Mosaic Conference board proposes withdrawal, partnership with MC USA

"Leaders of Mosaic Mennonite Conference, one of Mennonite Church USA's largest conferences, are recommending withdrawal from membership in the denomination while continuing in 'partnership and collaboration' with it. Mosaic's Conference Board on Aug. 19 affirmed a proposal by Mosaic's Pathways Steering Team, which began a process in 2022 to clarify the conference's priorities and its relationship with MC USA and other Anabaptist communities." **Read the rest of Tim Huber's article for Anabaptist World** here.

MC USA responds to Mosaic proposal with questions, disappointment

"Mennonite Church USA's Executive Board and staff responded with disappointment and questions to the Aug. 22 announcement by Mosaic Mennonite Conference that its leaders are recommending withdrawal from denominational membership while continuing in partnership and collaboration.

A Sept. 9 MC USA statement acknowledged the denomination has partnerships with former agencies such as Everence and MHS [Mennonite Health Services] Association but indicated there is no precedent for conferences to be in partnership outside the 'voluntary association' of conferences that already exists within MC USA. 'Such a major change would require involvement from all member conferences, a process that would involve the Constituency Leaders Council and likely not come to the MC USA Delegate Assembly until 2027,' said MC USA moderator-elect Marty Lehman in the MC USA release."
